Cavalier Land and WIND Mobile hosted an Open House on October 14th, 2015 at the Lake Bonavista Community Association, 1401 Acadia Drive SE for a telecommunications facility proposal. The proposal is for a 35m monopole tower with stealth antennas inside its shroud for WIND Mobile as well as a second cellular provider, and is located next to the Lake Bonavista Community Association (Rec Centre), 1401 Acadia Drive SE, Calgary, AB.

The interactive Open House seemed well received by the public, with representatives from the City of Calgary in attendance who provided positive feedback on the organization and format of the meeting. We were able to engage in meaningful conversations with many individuals from the community who attended in order to educate themselves on the proposal and to provide their feedback through discussion and the written questionnaire responses. 86 people attended the Open House along with two representatives from the City of Calgary Planning Department, the area Councillor and his assistant, and representatives from the Community Association Board. 86 people signed the sign in sheet, of which 62 individuals completed and submitted written questionnaires.

Below is a summary of the responses received to the standard questions from the 62 questionnaires submitted to Wind:

Space was also provided on the questionnaires for any additional comments and questions. Below is a summary of the additional feedback provided, tallying based upon the primary concerns raised.

Also two petitions have circulated among residents of the Lake Bonavista Community and among users of the Lake Bonavista Community Centre. The two petitions have been signed by 101 individuals, of which 70 are residents in the community and 31 are not residents. Seven additional emails have been received, addressed to Cavalier Land, from individuals not in favour of the proposal, which included five duplicates from individuals who previously completed the Open House questionnaires or signed either petition.
